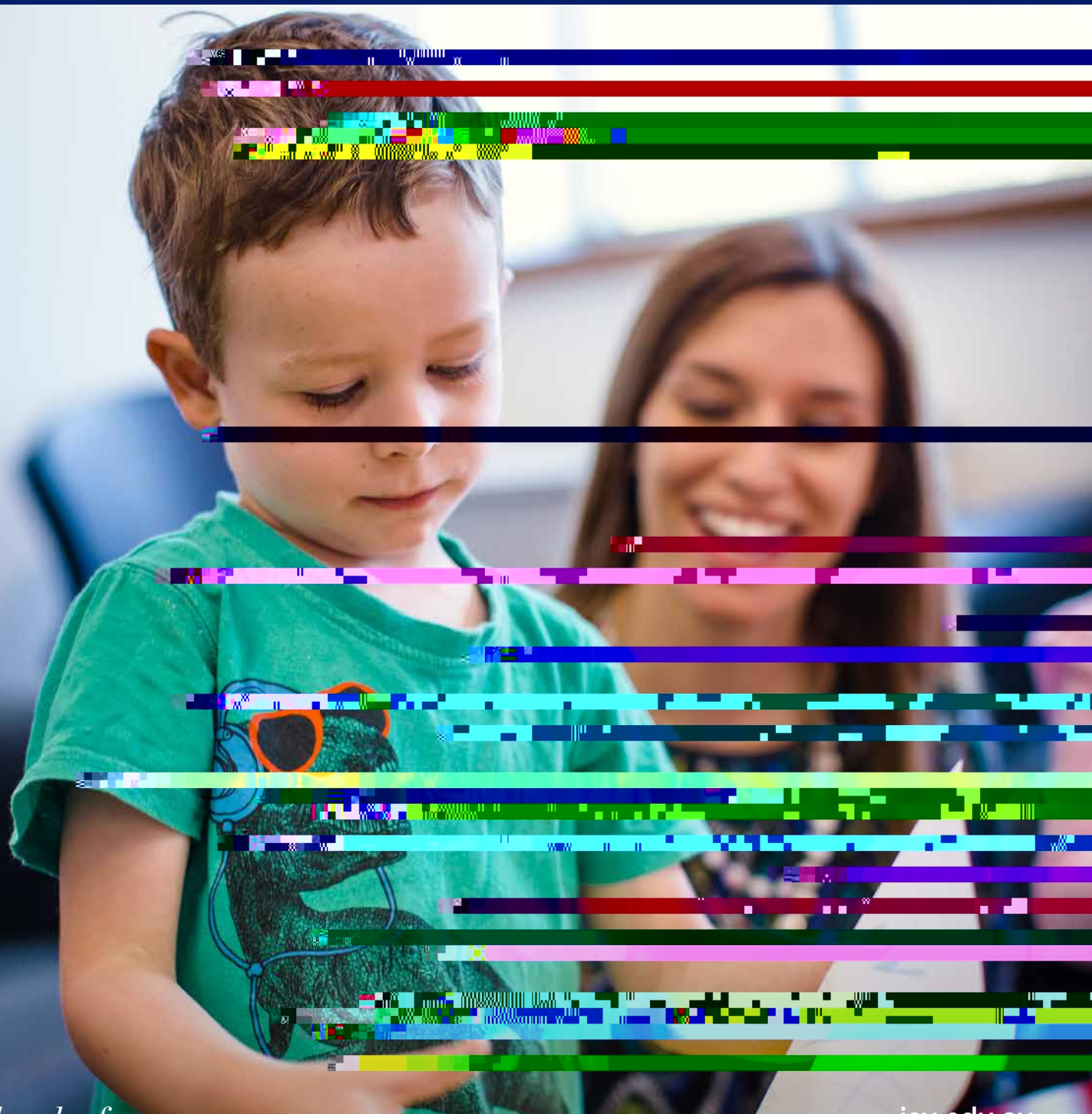
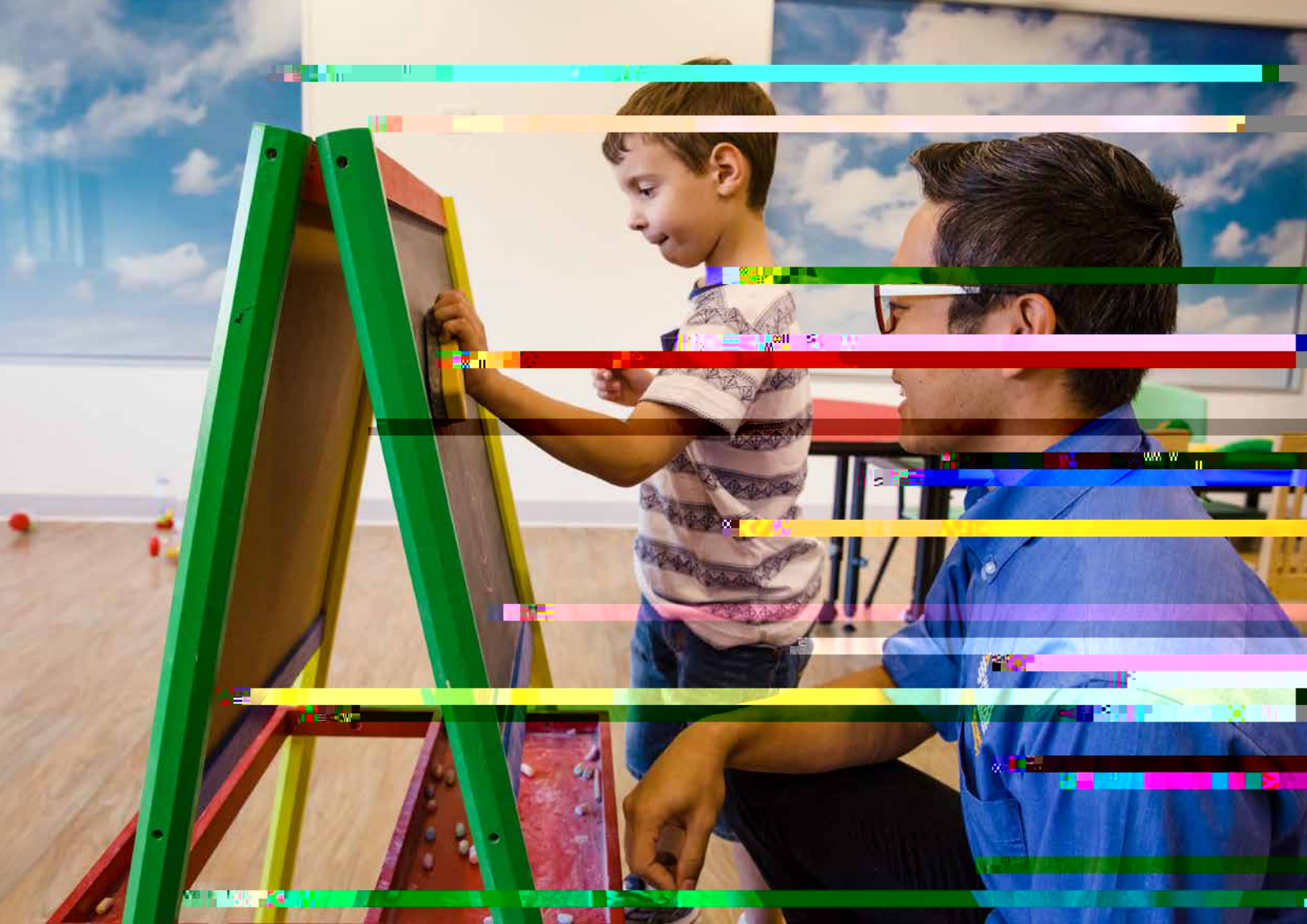

Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood Education)

- ✓ **Child Development (EDUC120)** - This course provides a foundation in child development from birth to age 8. It covers physical, cognitive, social, and emotional development, as well as the role of the family and community in child development.
- ✓ **Early Childhood Education (EDUC121)** - This course introduces students to the field of early childhood education. It covers the history and philosophy of early childhood education, the role of the teacher, and the importance of play in learning.
- ✓ **Child Health and Safety (EDUC122)** - This course focuses on the health and safety of children in early childhood settings. It covers topics such as nutrition, hygiene, first aid, and child protection.
- ✓ **Introduction to Early Childhood Education (EDUC123)** - This course provides an overview of the early childhood education profession. It covers the role of the teacher, the importance of play, and the challenges of working in early childhood settings.

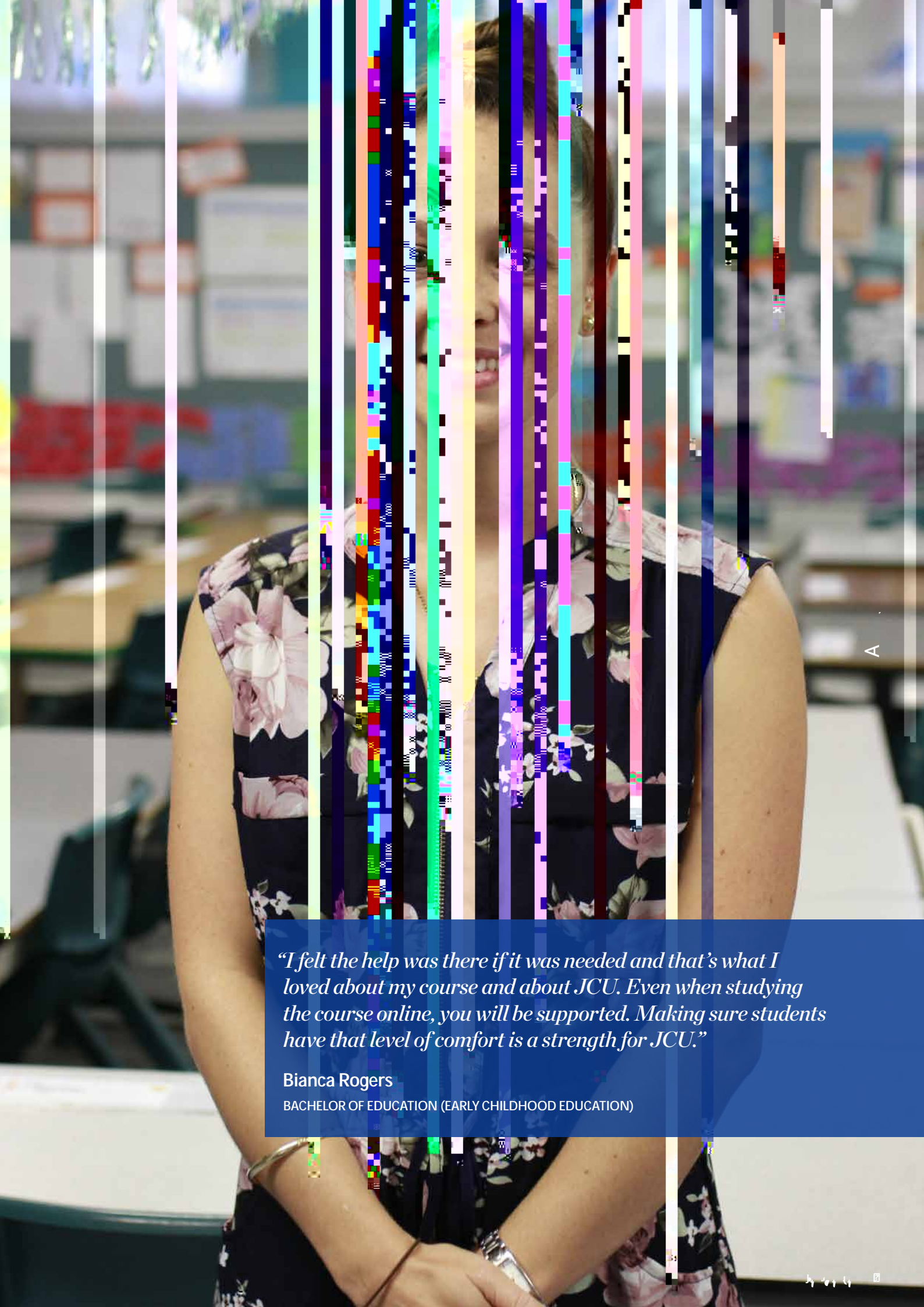
